★ **Live Performance by Betsy Ross**

Betsy Ross, famous for sewing the first United States “stars and stripes” flag, will discuss the challenges of being a female during the Revolutionary War. Students will observe as Ross, portrayed by Kim Hanley of American Historical Theatre, discuss her life, and challenges while she cuts out a five pointed star to be sewn onto the American flag.

★ **Tour the c. 1772 Jacobus Vanderveer House**

The Jacobus Vanderveer House was the headquarters of General Henry Knox during the winter of 1778-79 and is the only surviving building associated with the Pluckemin Artillery Cantonment, America’s first military academy. The Museum interprets 18th century Dutch-Colonial life and the American Revolution.
