



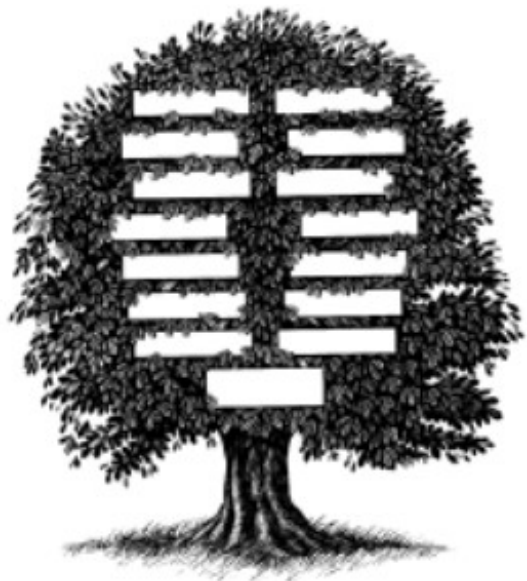

Interested in researching your family history but don't know where to begin?

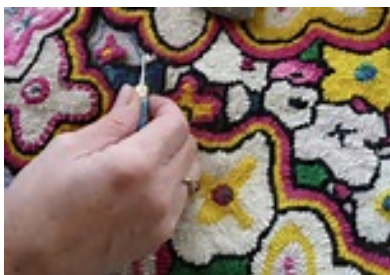

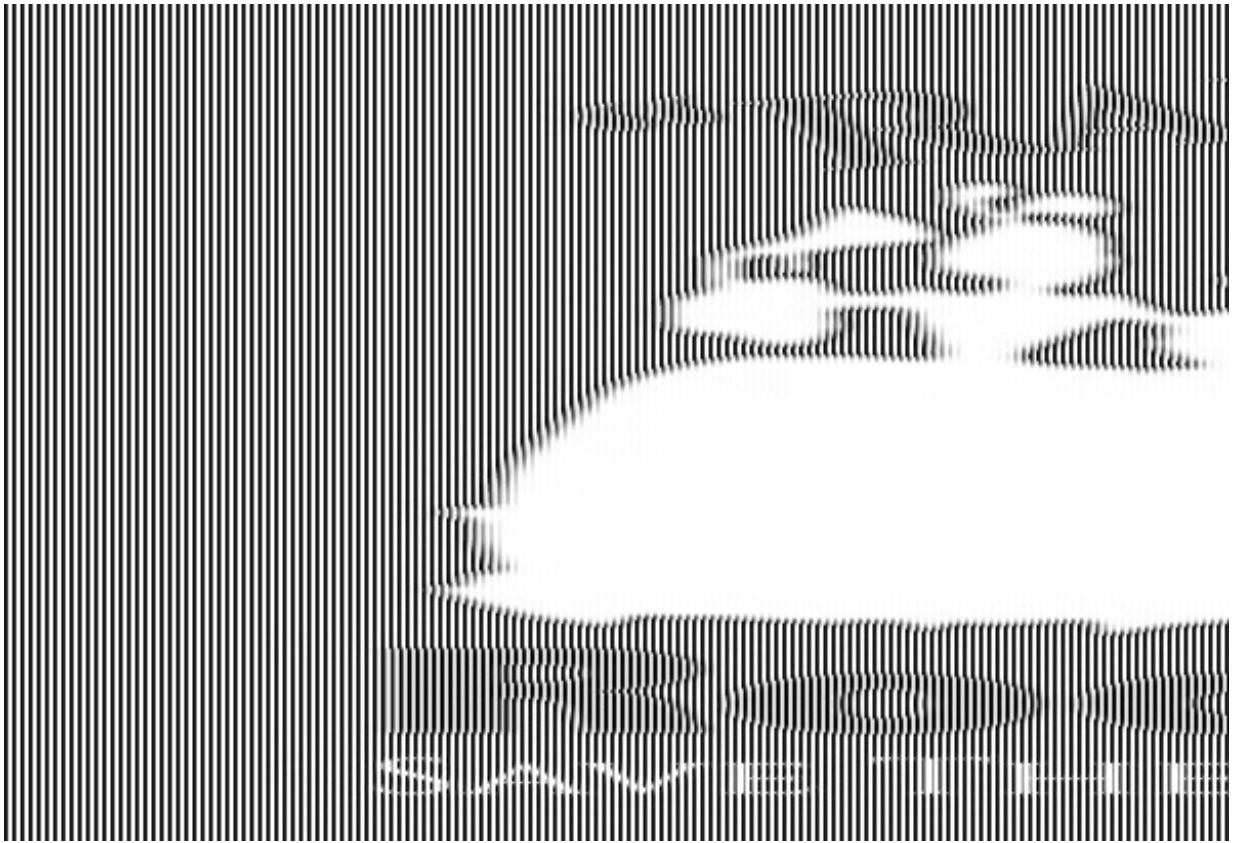
Open House, Sunday, March 26 from 1-4 pm
